

## *About Becky Rule, Mistress of Ceremonies*



Rebecca Rule is a full-time writer, humorist, storyteller, host for 10 years of the NH Authors Series on NHPTV, currently host of Our Hometown on NHPTV. She's been telling stories in New England, especially New Hampshire, for more than twenty years. She hasn't visited every town in the Granite State, but pretty close — speaking at libraries, historical societies, rotaries, clubs, church groups, and charitable organizations. Some of her talks are sponsored by the NH Humanities Council, which named her one of 40 Over 40, that is, one of 40 NH folks who over the past 40 years of the Council's existence “have demonstrated what it means to create, teach, lead, assist, and encourage human understanding.”

She's the author of eleven books including *N is for NH*, an ABC book, due out this fall. Other books include *The Iciest Diciest Scariest Sled Ride Ever!*, a picture book, illustrated by Jennifer Thermes; *Moved and Seconded: NH Town Meeting*; *Headin' for the Rhubarb, A NH Dictionary (well, kinda)*; and *The Best Revenge*, named one of five essential NH Books by NH Magazine and Outstanding Work of Fiction by the NH Writers Project.
